New program in Wyoming County for Veterans with Legal Issues

The Veteran Service Office is pleased to announce a new partnership with Neighborhood Legal Services. Beginning January 14th Lonnie Farrington will come to our office and assist Veterans with legal matters relating to public benefits, family law, disability law, housing, consumer issues and the NYSOH marketplace for health insurance. This free service is based on eligibility and they follow the federal poverty guidelines to determine financial eligibility. Guidelines may vary in regard to disability, welfare and domestic violence cases.

Lonnie is a veteran and served in the Airforce as a F-16 crew chief. When he was discharged from the military in 2006 he attended college using his G.I. Bill and worked his way through degrees in Criminal Justice and Sociology before applying and being accepted to UB Law School. He recently passed the New York State Bar and chose Neighborhood Legal Services as his first job to give back to the Veteran community.

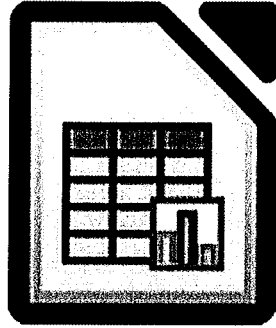
EUCHRE NIGHT
