New York State allocated a supply of KN95 masks to Wyoming County. The goal is to make these masks available throughout our communities, to help prevent the spread of illness during the winter months. Beginning Monday, December 27th, residents can pick up masks at the Health Department during business hours. Local businesses who wish to obtain a supply of masks can contact the Wyoming County Chamber of Commerce.

The Wyoming County Health Department is offering COVID-19 testing on Monday, Wednesday and Friday each week (except on holidays). Testing will be “drive through” style at the Wyoming County Highway Department located at 4328 Route 19, approximately 4 miles south of the Village of Warsaw. Results are available the same day and there is no charge. To schedule an appointment for a COVID-19 test please visit the Wyoming County Website. Walk-ins cannot be accepted. If you have questions or need help scheduling an appointment call the Wyoming County Response line at (585) 786-8911. Getting tested is free, peace of mind to gather with friends and family is priceless.

Wyoming County Board of Supervisors Chairwoman, Rebecca J. Ryan announced as of Thursday, December 23, 2021, the Wyoming County Health Department reports four thousand nine hundred forty-one (4,941) lab-confirmed positive community cases of COVID-19 among Wyoming County residents. This is an increase of one hundred fifty eight (158) cases since the last reported increase on Thursday, December 16, 2021. There are currently one hundred eleven (111) laboratory-confirmed active COVID-19 cases in Wyoming County.
