Wyoming County Board of Supervisors Chairwoman, Rebecca J. Ryan announced as of Thursday, January 7, 2021, the Wyoming County Health Department reports one thousand three hundred thirty-nine (1,339) lab-confirmed positive community cases of COVID-19 among Wyoming County residents. This is an increase of forty (40) cases from the last reported increase on Wednesday, January 6, 2021.

From the New York State Department of Health: If you are in the priority population per the NYS Vaccination Program Phase 1A guidelines, you are currently eligible to be vaccinated. Eligibility population guidance for Phase 1A vaccinations can be found at: <https://covid19vaccine.health.ny.gov/phased-distribution-vaccine>

Those eligible in the Phase 1A population are encouraged to register online at <https://apps.health.ny.gov/doh2/applinks/cdmspr/2/counties?OpID=50501100> for the clinic scheduled for Tuesday, January 12 from 9am to 3pm at the Wyoming County Highway Department, 4328 State Route 19, Silver Springs, NY 14550.

Eligible individuals must sign a statement and provide proof of eligibility at the vaccination clinic (i.e. a paystub or employer issued ID tag).

Please disseminate this information with Phase 1A colleagues that are in the current priority populations. Additional clinics will be scheduled in the near future based on supply of vaccine.
