**From the Wyoming County Department of Health:**

If you are in the Phase 1A or 1B Priority Population according to the NYS Department of Health [“Phased Distribution of the Vaccine”](#) guidelines, you are currently eligible to receive a COVID-19 vaccination.

The Wyoming County Health Department COVID-19 vaccine clinic for this week is complete. All doses received were administered according to specific instructions from NYS. Additional COVID-19 vaccination clinics will be scheduled when more vaccine is received. The Health Department cannot take reservations over the phone. Please check back frequently at [www.wyomingco.net](http://www.wyomingco.net) for updated information.

At current vaccine supply levels from NYS, it may take months to vaccinate everyone eligible in Phases 1A and 1B.

**Wyoming County Board of Supervisors Chairwoman, Rebecca J. Ryan** announced as of Friday, January 22, 2021, the Wyoming County Health Department reports one thousand seven hundred thirty-three (1,733) lab-confirmed positive community cases of COVID-19 among Wyoming County residents. This is an increase of thirty (30) cases from the last reported increase on Thursday, January 21, 2021.
