From the Wyoming County Department of Health:

If you are a member of Phase 1A or 1B Priority Population according to the NYS Department of Health [“Phased Distribution of the Vaccine”](#) guidelines, you are currently eligible to receive a COVID-19 vaccination.

New York State requires the Health Department to focus vaccination efforts on essential workers in Priority Population 1B and adults with certain pre-existing health conditions. There will be a 1st dose clinic scheduled this week, specifically for these groups. An appointment is required, watch www.wyomingco.net for the registration link.

Wyoming County Board of Supervisors Chairwoman, Rebecca J. Ryan announced as of Monday, February 22, 2021, the Wyoming County Health Department reports two thousand sixty-four (2,064) lab-confirmed positive community cases of COVID-19 among Wyoming County residents. This is an increase of twenty-two (22) cases from the last reported increase on Friday, February 19, 2021.
