**From the Wyoming County Department of Health:**

If you are a member of the Phase 1A or 1B Priority Population according to the NYS Department of Health [“Phased Distribution of the Vaccine”](#) guidelines, you are currently eligible to receive a COVID-19 vaccination. New York State is very specific about who is eligible to be vaccinated at particular locations.

**NEW:** Next week, the Wyoming County Health Department expects to receive Moderna COVID-19 vaccine that NYS directed to be used for essential workers in Priority Population 1B (this includes fire, law enforcement, public safety/communications, corrections, P-12 education employees, in-person college faculty, employees of registered group childcare programs, public transit, public-facing grocery workers, restaurant employees and others). Individuals being vaccinated must bring proof of eligibility to the vaccination site. This could be an employee ID card, a letter from an employer or affiliated organization, or a pay stub.

An appointment is required in order to be vaccinated. Registration will be announced shortly at [www.wyomingco.net](http://www.wyomingco.net) at “COVID-19 Vaccination Clinic Registration” under *County Quick Links*.

**Wyoming County Board of Supervisors Chairwoman, Rebecca J. Ryan** announced as of Wednesday, February 24, 2021, the Wyoming County Health Department reports two thousand eighty-four (2,084) lab-confirmed positive community cases of COVID-19 among Wyoming County residents. This is an increase of seven (7) cases from the last reported increase on Tuesday, February 23, 2021.
