**From the Wyoming County Department of Health:**

NYS announced updated guidelines for COVID-19 vaccine response. Individuals aged sixty years and older are now eligible to be vaccinated. Pharmacies with COVID-19 Vaccination Programs can vaccinate individuals age 60 years and older, as well as P-12 school faculty and staff and childcare workers.

Beginning March 17, public-facing government and public employees, not-for-profit workers who provide services to the public and essential in-person building service workers are eligible to receive COVID-19 vaccination. Also beginning March 17, health departments will be permitted to use allocated COVID-19 doses to vaccinate anyone who is an eligible member of Priority Groups identified by New York State. According to the New York State "COVID-19 Vaccine Tracker" website ([HERE](#)), 19.2% of Wyoming County residents have at least one COVID-19 vaccine dose (NYS average is 22.5%). Local officials are advocating for more doses to be allocated to Wyoming County

**Wyoming County Board of Supervisors Chairwoman, Rebecca J. Ryan** announced as of Monday, March 15, 2021, the Wyoming County Health Department reports two thousand two hundred twenty-seven (2,227) lab-confirmed positive community cases of COVID-19 among Wyoming County residents. This is an increase of twenty-two (22) cases from the last reported increase on Friday, March 12, 2021.
