NEW: The COVID-19 vaccination clinic scheduled for Thursday, April 1 is full; there are no appointments remaining. Frequently visit www.wyomingco.net for weekly vaccination clinic announcements from the Wyoming County Health Department.

Beginning Tuesday, April 6, New Yorkers 16 years of age and older (for Pfizer vaccine) or 18 years of age and older (for Moderna and Johnson & Johnson vaccine) can schedule appointments to receive the COVID-19 vaccine. Please be patient while the supply of vaccine increases to meet demand.

Wyoming County Board of Supervisors Chairwoman, Rebecca J. Ryan announced as of Wednesday, March 31, 2021, the Wyoming County Health Department reports two thousand three hundred thirteen (2,313) lab-confirmed positive community cases of COVID-19 among Wyoming County residents. This is an increase of six (6) cases from the last reported increase on Tuesday, March 30, 2021.
